#### **ADJUSTED BY HUD.**

---

- **\$122,300 = MEDIAN FAMILY INCOME** for STAMFORD/NORWALK CT HMFA (includes GREENWICH)
- **30% OF MEDIAN (EXTREMELY LOW INCOME)** is defined as 0% - 30% of the Median Family Income for the area, subject to specified adjustments for areas with unusually high or low income and/or housing costs.
- **VERY LOW INCOME** is defined as 31% - 50% of the Median Family Income for the area, subject to adjustments for areas with unusually high or low income and/or housing costs.
- **LOW-INCOME** is defined as 51% - 80% of the Median Family Income for the area, subject to adjustments for areas with unusually high or low income and/or housing costs.

Note: Greenwich falls within the Stamford/Norwalk Metropolitan Statistical Area, which is one of the highest income areas in the country and therefore subject to the adjustment. The adjustment is to the National Median Income.
