“Plants and Me! - Activities for K –6 Educators”

a Project Food, Land, and People workshop

Dates: March 14 and 21, 2007 – 2 sessions

Denise Savageau, Conservation Director for the Town of Greenwich and Lisa Beebe, GEC Horticulturist are teaming up to provide a hands-on workshop for teachers, scout leaders, nature center staff, and other educators. Join Denise and Lisa as they demonstrate activities such as “Seed Surprises”, “From Apple Core to Healthy Soil” and “Buzzy, Buzzy Bee”. Lisa will also give a tour of the GEC greenhouse – a special treat in March!

The 2-session workshop will center on plant science basics including plant anatomy, plant propagation, and soil and composting, and will be designed to complement existing science curriculum objectives. Although the focus will be on grades K-6, most activities are adaptable to all grade levels. All participants will receive a copy of the Project Food, Land, and People activity guide, a national environmental education curriculum aid. Teachers will also receive .6 CEUs. Participants must attend both sessions to receive materials and CEUs.
