- HOME:** Bug spray
- Floor care products
- Furniture polish
- Metal polish in solvent
- Lighter fluid
- Mothballs
- GARAGE:** Automatic transmission fluid
- Car wax in solvent
- Diesel fuel
- Fuel oil
- Gasoline
- Kerosene
- Other oils
- Antifreeze and brake fluid
- GARDEN & YARD:** Fungicide
- Herbicide or weed killer
- Insecticide
- Rat poison
- Swimming pool acid
- WORKSHOP:** Cutting oil
- Glue - solvent based
- Paint - oil based
- Paint cleaner in solvent
- Paint primer, thinner, stripper
- Turpentine and varnish
- Wood preservative
- Photographic chemicals

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

- Asbestos
- Kepone and derivatives
- Highly reactive materials
- Bulk containers of herbicides, pesticides
- Gas cylinders
- Radioactive materials
- Explosives
- PCBs and derivatives
- Infectious waste
- Unknowns

RECYCLE THESE AT TRANSFER STATION

- Pack like materials carefully in boxes lined with newspaper or kitty litter
