No. 9613-(Continued). **74 BENJAMIN STREET, OLD GREENWICH.** Appeal of Edward Daly for variances of number of stories, of required front and side yards ratio to permit additions to a dwelling in the R-12 zone was granted.

No. 9621. **16 WEAVER STREET, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Enzo Cancellieri for variance of number of number of stories and of required front yard to permit additions to a dwelling in the R-6 zone was granted.

No. 9622. **22 HOLLOW WOOD LANE, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Franco Fazzolari for variance of building height to permit a dwelling to remain in the R-6 zone was granted.

No. 9623. **4 TOWER LANE, OLD GREENWICH.** Appeal of Peter and Stina Klein for variances of required side and rear yards to permit an accessory garage at a dwelling in the R-12 zone was granted with conditions.

No. 9624. **264 WEST PUTNAM AVENUE, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Michael Claroni for special exception approval to permit a veterinary practice at a commercial building in the GB zone was continued.

No. 9625. **50 DUNCAN DRIVE, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Stacy and Jeffery Young for variance of required rear yard and of number of stories to permit additions to a dwelling in the RA-1 zone was granted.

No. 9626. **18 SIMMONS LANE, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Olga Kogan for special exception approval to permit indoor athletic facilities at a dwelling in the RA-2 zone was continued.

No. 9627. **91 SOUTH EAST ELM STREET, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Raymond and Honda Silcock for variance of grade plane wall height at a dwelling in the R-6 zone was dismissed.
