## DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

### LABORATORY BLOOD TESTING SERVICES

- Offered by The Greenwich Health Department Environmental Services Laboratory.
- No appointment is needed.
- Blood is drawn Monday – Friday, 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

#### PREMARITAL BLOOD TESTING – finger stick method

- These tests are in compliance with the marriage laws of the State of Connecticut.
- Both men and women are tested for syphilis.
- Women under 50 are tested for immunity to rubella. This may be waived for women who are over age 50 or who can provide proof of immunity to rubella.
- Results are available in two business days.
- Each person must pick up his or her own results.
- The fee is \$32.00 for men and \$64.00 for women who require rubella testing.

#### BLOOD LEAD TESTING – finger stick method

- This screening service is provided for children 1 to 6 years old. It is appropriate for parents who feel their children may have been exposed to lead (i.e., an old house or home renovation).
- Results are available within two weeks.
- The fee is \$16.00 per test.
