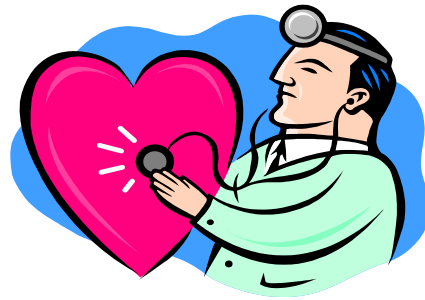

REDUCING YOUR RISK OF HEART
DISEASE**



This **FREE** four session course is for individuals who could be at risk of developing heart disease. In addition to exploring individual risk factors for the development of heart disease, such as high cholesterol, high blood pressure, metabolic syndrome and family history, strategies for modifying life styles will be examined and individualized plans will be developed.

FREE cholesterol testing will be offered. Metabolic syndrome screening that will include blood pressure measurement, blood sugar testing and waist girth measurement will be available.
