**OPENING DAY**

The Skating Rink will open for user groups on Tuesday, September 8, 2009, for the 2009-2010 season. Limited public session schedule begins Saturday, September 12, 2009. Full public session schedule will begin Tuesday, October 13, 2009.

**REGISTRATION**

Registration for all programs by **MAIL ONLY** from August 31, 2009 through September 14, 2009.

**Registration cannot be postmarked prior to AUGUST 31, 2009.** Completed registration forms with full payment must be mailed in care of the **Department of Parks and Recreation, PO Box 2540, Greenwich CT 06836-2540, Attention: Skating Rink.** Note: **Copies of Birth Certificates must accompany registrations for: Mommy Daddy & Me and Snowplow Sam Classes, Pre-Hockey 1, and 6 and 7 year olds in the Youth Hockey Instructional Clinic.** Applications will be processed in the order received. The Department of Parks and Recreation will not be responsible for delays in mail service. In person, resident registration will begin Wednesday, September 16, 2009 at the Skating Rink 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays, through October 24, 2009.

Checks should be made payable to: **TOWN OF GREENWICH.** Full payment required at time of registration.

**REFUND POLICY:**

**NO REFUNDS** will be given. A letter of Credit **ONLY CONSIDERED** if request is received in writing prior to start of program. **Each program requires separate payment.**

NOTE: Discounts will be given for more than one family member enrolled in the following programs:

*Hockey* - Youth Clinic, Novice Youth League, Senior Youth League **ONLY**

OR

*Skating School* - Group skating lessons (3 to adult), tot skating lessons, pre-hockey and teen **ONLY.**

Program space is limited. A waiting list will be established on all closed programs. If an opening should occur, waiting list applicants will be notified. The management reserves the right to cancel classes due to lack of enrollment.

We provide free admission for the birthday child. Private room for your party (tables and chairs provided) and skating for length of public sessions are included. Public Sessions run 1 ½ hours during the week and 2 hours on weekends. Only one birthday party can be scheduled during each public session. You are welcome to bring your own cake. Any other food or drink must be purchased through "The Penalty Box" Rink Concession (203-531-5015).

## **HAMILL RINK NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION FUND RAISERS**

The Hamill Rink has a limited amount of ice slots which may be used as a fundraiser for Greenwich based fundraisers: Greenwich School PTAs, Churches, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc. Letters requesting a session may be submitted to the Recreation Office starting September 1, 2009. Requests will be handled on a first come, first served basis. The admission price is **\$5.00** per person for 1 ½ hour sessions. The Rink receives the first \$60.00. ## **HOCKEY**

Programs available: Youth Hockey Clinic (Co-Ed 6-10 years), Novice Youth Hockey League (Co-Ed 7-10 years), Senior Youth Hockey League (Co-Ed 11-14 years). **We are fall sport friendly; if your child is involved in another fall sport, please try to have him/her attend at least one early season practice/evaluation to ensure proper team placement.**

## **STAFF**

Frank "Skeets" Yantorno, who has over 30 years of coaching and administrative experience at various levels of the sport, heads the Greenwich Youth Hockey Program.

### **\* GREENWICH YOUTH HOCKEY INSTRUCTIONAL CLINIC - Activity 31202**

Offers concentrated teaching in the fundamental skills of hockey, such as skating forward and backward, stopping, power turns, stick-handling, passing and shooting. Groups are subdivided by ability on the ice to enable each skater to progress at a pace that is comfortable to the child. The Clinic is primarily offered to children ages 6-10, however, exceptions will be made for those children who are older, but who may be just taking up the sport. Time will be reserved for periodic, full ice scrimmages, so that youngsters may try out their newly learned skills in a fun atmosphere. Sessions will be held each **Saturday from October 3 through March 6 from 11:10 am to 12:10 pm**. Players will be divided into smaller groups for instruction. The fee is **\$220** for the season and **\$210** for each additional child in the family enrolled in the program. Equipment required for the Instructional Clinic is: Hockey skates, approved helmet with face shield, hockey stick, collar-type throat protector, and gloves. Full hockey equipment including hockey pants, shin pads, cup, elbow pads and shoulder pads is recommended. **Note: Copy of Birth Certificate must accompany registration for 6 and 7 year old registrants.**

### **\* GREENWICH NOVICE YOUTH HOCKEY LEAGUE – Activity 31203**

This program is a four team structured league for players beginning to participate in a team-play environment. Most players are between the ages of 7-10 and league and team placement is entirely at the discretion of the on-ice coaching staff. This league plays approximately ten games, with additional skill development and team practice times. There is a large emphasis on skill development in the areas of skating, passing and shooting, as well as work on position play and team work. Playoffs and standings are not included in the Novice Youth League. Each team will have its own coaches assigned. The cost is **\$300** per child, **\$290** for additional family members enrolled in the program. Required equipment includes: Hockey skates, approved helmet with face shield, collar-type throat protector, hockey stick, hockey gloves, cup, shoulder pads, shin and elbow pads. Full hockey equipment including hockey pants is recommended. **This is a non-checking league.** Sessions on Saturday mornings are scheduled for 9:20 am and 10:20 am with weekday practices scheduled in the early evening on Thursdays. The program will start October 3, 2009.

**\* GREENWICH SENIOR YOUTH HOCKEY LEAGUE – Activity 31204**

This program is a four team structured league for players who have some prior team experience. While most players are between the ages of 11-14, league and team placement is entirely at the discretion of the on-ice coaching staff. This league plays approximately 15 games with team practices and "Skill Development" sessions intermixed in the season. Officials, standings and scoreboard will be in use for all games. Coaches will be assigned to teams for the entire season and will work on previously learned hockey skills while incorporating team philosophy and team play. The cost is **\$300** for each child and **\$290** for additional family members enrolled in the league. Required equipment includes: Hockey skates, approved helmet with face shield, collar-type throat protector, hockey stick, hockey gloves, cup, shoulder pads, shin pads and elbow pads. Full hockey equipment including hockey pants is recommended. **This is a non-checking league.** Sessions on Saturday mornings are scheduled for 7:00 am and 8:10 am, with weekday practices scheduled in the early evening on Thursdays. The program will start October 3, 2009.

**\* Hamill Rink Stick Sessions**

The Dorothy Hamill Skating Rink will offer a number of "Stick Sessions" during the 2009-2010 season. A "Stick Session" allows a participant to skate with a stick and puck in an informal atmosphere. **NO GAMES PLAYED!** Participants must supply their own stick and puck, and wear hockey skates, a helmet with full-face shield and hockey gloves. Proof of Greenwich residency is required. This is open to any age, but an adult must accompany children under 8. On-ice supervision is provided, and must be obeyed. Fee is \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for children under 15.

## GREENWICH SKATING SCHOOL

The Greenwich Skating School is under the direction of Nancy Leamy, who holds the rating of two-time National and International Coach by the U.S.F.S.A.

### Group Skating Lessons

**SESSION I** - October 13, 2009 – December 12, 2009 – **Activity 31201**

**SESSION II** - January 4, 2010 - March 6, 2010 – **Activity 31209**

All classes are 30 minutes long and classes run for 8 weeks. The cost is **\$105** for 8 weeks, **\$95** for each additional family member enrolled. Class fees include four (4) practice sessions and badge testing. **A family skating party with refreshments is an added feature held at the end of each session (Sat., Dec. 12, 4:15 p.m.- 5:30 p.m., Session I)(Sat., Mar. 6, 4:15 p.m. – 5:30 p.m., Session II).** United States Figure Skating Association Skate with US program is used. Classes are limited for maximum instructor attention. **Mail-In registration for Session II will begin Monday, December 14, 2009. In-person registration begins on Monday, Dec. 28, 2009.**

### REQUIREMENTS TO PASS EACH SKILL LEVEL

#### **BASIC 1**

- A. Sit on ice and stand up
- B. March forward across the ice
- C. Forward two-foot glide
- D. Dip
- E. Forward swizzles - 6-8 in a row
- F. Backward wiggles - 6-8 in a row
- G. Snowplow Stop
- H. Rocking horse - 2-3
- I. Two-foot hop in place (Optional)

#### **BASIC 2**

- A. Forward one-foot glides - R&L
- B. Backward two-foot glide.
- C. Backward swizzles - 6-8 in a row.
- D. Two-foot turn from forward to backward in place
- E. Moving snowplow stop
- F. Forward alternating 1/2 swizzle pumps, in a straight line (slalom like pattern)

#### **BASIC 3**

- A. Forward stroking, showing correct use of blade
- B. Forward 1/2 swizzle pumps on a circle - 6-8 consecutive clockwise and counter clockwise.
- C. Moving forward to backward two-foot turn - clockwise and counter clockwise
- D. Backward one-foot glides - right and left
- E. Forward Slalom
- F. Two-foot spin - up to 2 revolutions

#### **BASIC 4**

- A. Forward outside edge on a circle - right and left
- B. Forward inside edge on a circle - right and left
- C. Forward crossovers, clockwise and counter-clockwise
- D. Forward outside three-turn, right and left, from a stand still position
- E. Backward 1/2 swizzle pumps on a circle, clockwise and counter-clockwise
- F. Backward stroking
- G. Backward snowplowing stop - right and left

#### **BASIC 5**

- A. Backward outside edge on a circle - right and left
- B. Backward inside edge on a circle - right and left
- C. Backward crossovers, clockwise and counter-clockwise
- D. Beginning one-foot spin - up to 3 revolutions, optional entry and free foot position
- E. Hockey stop
- F. Side toe hop - both directions

#### **BASIC 6**

- A. Forward inside three turn, right and left, from a standstill position
- B. Moving backward to forward two-foot turn on a circle, clockwise and counter-clockwise.
- C. T-stop, right or left
- D. Bunny hop.
- E. Forward arabesque/spiral on a straight line - right or left
- F. Forward lunge - right or left

#### **BASIC 7**

- A. Forward inside open Mohawk from a standstill position - right to left and left to right
- B. Backward outside edge to forward outside edge transition on a circle  
- right or left
- C. Ballet jump - right or left
- D. Backward crossovers to a backward outside edge glides (landing position), clockwise and counter-clockwise
- E. Forward inside pivots, right or left

#### **BASIC 8**

- A. Moving forward outside three-turn on a circle - right or left
- B. Moving forward inside three-turn on a circle - right or left
- C. Combination move: Forward crossovers (2) into forward inside Mohawk, cross behind, step into backward crossover (1) and step to forward inside edge - repeat 3 times, clockwise and counter-clockwise
- D. One-foot upright spin, optional entry and free foot position

## **YOUTH (3- 15)**

Classes for youth will follow the U.S.F.S.A. Skate with US badge program.

## **MOMMY, DADDY & ME (3-4)**

This class is open to children ages 3 and 4, **accompanied on the ice with a parent or other adult relative or “sitter” who skates.** This is a strictly beginner class. Children must be three years old on the first day of class; October 13, 2009 for Fall, January 4, 2010 for Spring. Children must exhibit capability to function in this class. It will be offered only on Wednesdays from 12:45 p.m. – 1:15 p.m. to provide a quiet atmosphere on the ice.

**NOTE: Copy of Birth Certificate MUST accompany registration for Mommy, Daddy and Me classes.**

## **SNOWPLOW SAM PROGRAM (4-5)**

Classes are open to children ages 4 and 5. **Children must be 4 years old before December 12, 2009 for the Fall Session and March 6, 2010 for the Spring Session.** There are two levels. Snowplow Sam 1 is for the child who has never been on the ice. Snowplow Sam 2 and 3 is for the child who has been on the ice before and has good forward movement.

**NOTE: Copy of Birth Certificate MUST accompany registration for Snowplow Sam classes.**

## **BRIDGE PROGRAM**

This is a new program and is designed to teach students who have achieved a skating level of Basic 6 through Freestyle 8, at a faster pace and in a group lesson environment. Each student will be introduced to skills such as: Proper Stretching Techniques, Edge and Power Skating, Intro to Moves in The Field, Intro to Ice Dancing and more!

## **ADULTS (16+)**

Adult Classes will follow the U.S.F.S.A. badge programs for classes offered in basic skating, dance, patch and freestyle.

## **PRE-HOCKEY CLASS**

Open to boys and girls 6-12 years who have completed the Basic 1 level of skating or its equivalent. The class follows the U.S.F.S.A. hockey badge program. The emphasis in this class is the mastery of skating skills and hockey fundamentals necessary to play. It offers the basics of stick handling and skating. Pre-Hockey 2 begins to develop stick handling, passing, shooting, and positional play. It further develops the skating skills. Students without prior experience should register for Pre-Hockey 1. Students who completed Pre-Hockey 1 last year, should register for Pre-Hockey 2. Students who completed Pre-Hockey 2 last year should register for the Saturday Instructional Clinic. Required equipment for Pre-Hockey 1 includes hockey skates, helmet with full cage shield, collar-type throat protector and hockey stick. Pre-Hockey 2 **requires** Pre-Hockey 1 equipment plus gloves, shin pads, hockey pants and shoulder pads. Full hockey equipment is strongly recommended for all levels. The fee for Pre-Hockey 1 or 2 is **\$105** for the first child and **\$95** for each sibling.

**Note: Copy of Birth Certificate must accompany registration for Pre-Hockey 1 Class.**
