In consideration of the willingness of The Town of Greenwich, Department of Parks and Recreation (the "Department") to provide access to the Greenwich Skatepark, I hereby waive for myself and on behalf of my child or ward, and any persons claiming by, through or under me or them, any and all claims or causes of action which I or my child or ward now or hereafter may have against the Department, Town of Greenwich, its officers, agents, servants, and employees, for all injuries and damages suffered arising from use of the Skatepark or while at the Skatepark for any other reason.

I acknowledge that in-line skating and skateboarding and other physical activities at the Skatepark involve the risk of serious bodily injury and I fully accept and assume all risks and all responsibilities for all losses and damages incurred as a result of my participation, and the participation by my child or ward, in these activities.

I acknowledge that all persons using the Skatepark pursuant to this Agreement are in good health and good physical condition.

I have read the Rules of the Skatepark and understand that full gear is required including but not limited to helmet, elbow and kneepads, and wrist guards, and I will abide by them in full.

I have explained the Rules to my child and/or ward and agree that the staff of the Department may deny further use of the Skatepark to any person who violates the Rules.

I agree to indemnify, defend and save harmless the Department, and The Town of Greenwich, and its officers, agents, employees, and servants from and against all claims, suits, judgments liabilities and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of the use of the Skatepark as contemplated by this Agreement.

### **Skateboard Rules**

Skaters are expected to follow the rules listed below plus any directions given by the Skatepark staff. Failure to do so may result in the loss of skating privileges, and NO REFUNDS will be given.

1. All skaters must sign in with attendant.
2. All skaters must sign Waiver/Release forms. Minors must have a parent or guardian sign.
3. All skaters assume risk of injury. The Town of Greenwich and its agents are not responsible for any injuries.
4. Skaters must wear proper safety equipment, including But not limited to, helmets, knee and elbow pads. Wrist Guards are required for inliners, optional for skaterboarders.
5. No trespassing after park hours.
6. Skatepark can only be used when a monitor is on site.
7. No bicycles, roller skates or scooters are permitted inside this facility.
8. No littering. Please use trash containers.
9. Do not use ramps or obstacles that are beyond your ability level.
10. No food or beverages in the skating area
11. Skaters under 10 years of age must be accompanied by Someone 18 years of age or older.
12. No climbing on the fence.
13. No alcohol, smoking, drugs, foul language, Inappropriate behavior, glass containers, or loud music.
14. Shirts are required at all times.
15. No headsets or stereo's allowed in the park.

### **Skatepark Capacity Policy**

1. The maximum number of skaters allowed in the Park at any one time is forty - (40). (It does not matter if not all 40 are skating.)
2. When capacity is reached no participants may enter the Park. They need to form a line outside the gate area.
3. If no one leaves the Park after two (2) hours the first ten (10) or less (depending on how many are waiting) that signed in will be asked to leave the Skatepark to allow the skaters that are waiting a turn. If there are still participants waiting, every half hour we will ask five (5) more on the sign in list to leave to let five (5) more participants into the Park.
4. When participants are asked to leave, they may get in line outside the fenced area and wait their turn to reenter the Park.
5. It does not matter what type of membership you have, you still will have to leave the Park depending on when you sign up.
6. Everyone will be guaranteed a minimum of two (2) hours of skating.
7. No refunds for having to wait if you are asked to leave the Park after two (2) hours.

### **Skatepark Rain Policy**

1. If it rains before the Skatepark opens please call the Skatepark at 203-496-9876 to gain information on opening. If it has stopped raining there may be a delayed opening if the ramps or asphalt are still wet.
2. If it rains after the Park has opened and the Park has to close, participants with ten (10) day passes and day passes may request a rain check. The rain check will enable the participant to use the Park on another day for free. Rain checks will be given to anyone who has been skating at the Park for less than two (2) hours when the Park has to close. Anyone who has been there over two (2) hours will not be eligible for a rain check. No refunds will be given. Staff must sign the rain check Receipt.
3. The rain check must be presented to the attendant in order for the participant to come in for free the next time they visit the Park.
4. If the rain check is lost you will not be allowed into the Park for free on your next visit.
5. If the Park opens back up that same day and the skater wants to reenter the Park he will have to relinquish his rain check at that time.
