The Greenwich Police make two arrests in the Andrew Kissel homicide.

On April 3, 2006 at approximately 9:42 A.M., Greenwich Police were detailed to 10 Dairy Road on a report of a deceased male subject being found within the residence by moving company personnel.

A subsequent investigation by members of the Criminal Investigations Division and the State's Medical Examiner's Office determined that the deceased was the victim of a Homicide and he was identified as Andrew M. Kissel, Age 46, DOB- August 23, 1959 of 10 Dairy Road, Greenwich, CT.

Members of this department have actively investigated this case for almost two years, which has now resulted in the arrest of two subjects.

During the afternoon of Friday, March 21, 2008, Greenwich Police working closely with the State's Attorney's Office, Stamford, Connecticut, obtained two arrest warrants in this case.

At approximately 9:45pm on Friday, March 21, 2008, Greenwich Police arrested:

Carlos Trujillo, Age 47, DOB-02/17/1961 of 168 Court D, Building 62, Bridgeport, Connecticut for the charge of:

Conspiracy to Commit Murder. CGS-53a-48 (53a-54e) Felony

Carlos Trujillo's arrest occurred in Stratford, Connecticut.

Greenwich Police, assisted by Stratford Police and agents from DEA-Bridgeport, conducted a motor vehicle stop of Trujillo on a highway adjacent to US 1. Trujillo was removed from the vehicle and taken into custody without incident.

Carlos Trujillo was then transported to Greenwich Police Headquarters where he is currently being held on \$1,000,000 Cash bond. Trujillo's Court Date is scheduled for March 28, 2008; however, if he is unable to make bond he will be presented in Stamford Superior on Monday, March 24.

Hours after Carlos Trujillo's arrest, during the morning of Saturday, March 22, 2008, a second arrest was made in the Kissel homicide:

Leonard Trujillo, Age, 21, DOB 05/05/1986, 63-13 Outlook Drive, Worcester, Massachusetts was arrested for:

***Murder- CGS- 53a- 54e- Felony
Conspiracy to Commit Murder- CGS- 53a-48(53a-54e) Felony***

Leonard Trujillo was arrested without incident and taken into custody at his home in Worcester, Massachusetts by Worcester PD Detectives at the request of the Greenwich Police Department.

Leonard Trujillo is currently being held without bond at Worcester PD pending a court appearance in Worcester District Court on Monday, March 24. Any questions about the extradition process should be directed to the State's Attorney's Office, Stamford, Connecticut.

Chief Ridberg said, "While I am proud of the hard work done by my Detectives in this investigation, it is far from over. There is still a lot of information to be gathered and facts to be discerned."

This is an ongoing investigation and the court has sealed the arrest warrants.

The Greenwich Police Department has worked with many police departments and other law enforcement agencies in this investigation.

We thank them all and will publicly acknowledge them at a press conference on Monday. Further details on the press conference will be made available at the earliest opportunity.
