### New Business

- Mike Dinan of the *Greenwich Time* sat in on the meeting and we anticipate a brief article on the west sector group being published in the near future.
- With the first anniversary of CAPP approaching, will look into feasibility of conducting another town wide CAPP meeting.
- In conjunction with new members coming on board, Capt. Ridberg will poll original members as to their desire to remain active in the group.
- In response to historical parking and speeding problems on Hamilton Avenue, Capt. Ridberg will have a traffic counter placed on Hamilton Avenue when feasible. He also recommended that Rob Roina approach the Chickahominy Homeowners Association to advocate for an additional Parking Enforcement Officer (PEO) for Chickahominy. This could be in conjunction with the need for another PEO for Byram and perhaps Pemberwick.
- Capt. Ridberg distributed "Suggested Criteria for CAPP Involvement":
  - Multi-agency involvement
  - Quality of Life issue
  - Neighborhood issue
  - Significant local impact
  - Town liability issue
  - Can CAPP make a difference?
  - Consensus of group
  - Priority compared to other issues
  - Supporting evidence
