### OLD BUSINESS

- Received positive comments from Ms. Sixsmith on CAPP's organization and enthusiasm. She is recommending a similar program in New Canaan.
- Monthly statistics were handed out for May and were discussed briefly.
- Byram Park has been the scene of vandalism and after-hours gatherings that could be leading to other illegal activities in the late night/early morning hours. Information provided by CAPP members was passed on to area patrols, and some teens were arrested after hours. No further vandalisms have been reported.
- Members had been advised that the East CAPP group had sent a letter to town officials in support of a School Resource Officer (SRO). Ron Brien is drafting a letter on behalf of West CAPP members.
- Fireworks will be held 7/1 at Greenwich Point. (The event went off as scheduled and was generally reviewed in a positive manner.)

**ONGOING ACTIVITIES**

- Information gleaned from the 1200 teen survey cards was shared with United Way and Youth Services Council. Fifty-dollar gift certificates have been handed out to the winners.
- CAPP and GPD will continue to support the GPD Greenwich Youth Initiative which has now become part of the Junior United Way's Youth Initiative program.
- Letter from West CAPP group to Board of Education expressing concern over non-resident students has now been forwarded to appropriate people.
- Capt. Ridberg attended Board of Selectmen meeting on behalf of GPD advocating an elevated walkway at Western Junior Highway. DPW has been charged with evaluating the project and reporting back to Board of Education.
