The Greenwich Police Department was notified by the State of Connecticut Medical Examiner's Office, that an autopsy was conducted this morning on Andrew Michael Kissel, found dead within his residence, 10 Dairy Road on April 3, 2006. Mr. Kissel's body had been positively identified by law enforcement personnel on April 3rd.

The preliminary findings of the autopsy indicate that Mr. Kissel's death was the result of multiple stab wounds.

Mr. Kissel was last seen alive late in the afternoon on Sunday, April 2, 2006 by an acquaintance.

Due to the size of the residence, police personnel will be at the house for at least another 24 hours to complete the processing of the scene and searching of the property. Today, with the assistance of fire personnel, the pool on the property was drained to aid in the search.

The investigation is ongoing, and further information will be released to the public when available.

Please bear with us as we continue to investigate this tragic event and understand that the release of specific information prematurely could jeopardize the outcome of the investigation.
