September 24, 2009

Minutes of a special meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on September 24, 2009.

Present were First Selectman Peter J. Tesei, Selectmen Lin Lavery and Peter J. Crumbine, and members of the Press and Public.

The meeting opened at 10:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes for the Board meeting of September 10, 2009 were reviewed and approved without objection.

New Business

- Melissa Evans, from DPW, spoke about a new State law that prohibits blocking traffic intersections and becomes effective on October 1st. She handed out a draft ordinance that would conform Town ordinances to the State. She said that DPW and the Police were considering which traffic intersections within the Town should be designated and signed under this program. Following a number of questions from the members of the Board of Selectman a motion was made to approve the ordinance without objection.

- Rich Feminella, from DPW, spoke to the Board about a blockage in a sanitary sewer line on Field Point Road in front of Town Hall. He said that the line needed to be excavated and he requested approval for a partial road closure. Rich Feminella and Melissa Evans reviewed the traffic plan that was being prepared to minimize the impact of the repair work on traffic at this busy section of the road. The Board approved the road closure without objection.

- John Crary, Town Administrator, gave a brief report on the work of the First Selectman's Working Group on Senior Citizen Tax Deferral Option. He said that the committee expects to complete their deliberations and vote on their recommendations at their next meeting on October 1st.
