**Social Services to the Senior Center and at Town Hall.**

Senior Center: Monday & Wednesday 10:00 - 12:30.

Town Hall: Monday - Friday 9:00 - 5:00

**Services Include:**

- Assistance with State and Federal programs.
- Medicare related issues. Medicaid - Title XIX.
- Requests for assistance with housing and nursing homes.
- Counseling families with elderly relative for care and placement.

**Care Management provides assistance to clients and their families.**

- Protective Services for people 65 and over - Elderly clients in danger of abuse, exploitation, or neglect (including dangerous self-neglect). Assist families for conservatorship through Probate Court when needed. This may involve extensive family work, and coordination of service with community agencies.
- Information and Referral on matters relating to seniors, including housing, nursing homes, home care, conservatorships, Living Wills, powers of attorney, and many other issues.
- Help with applications or benefit and entitlement programs: Social Security, SSI, Medicare, Medicaid, ConnPace, Energy Assistance, Operation Fuel, Renter's Rebate, and other benefits and programs.
- Follow-up and monitoring of client referral from community agencies and families, via telephone or home visits as appropriate.
