PHEASANT HARVEST TAG INFORMATION

All persons wishing to hunt pheasants must purchase a pheasant harvest tag series in addition to a small game hunting license. Your activities relating to the previous season must be reported when making application for pheasant tags. Applications are available in the Town Clerk’s office.

INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Pick up pink Application for Pheasant Harvest tag (example below) from Town Clerk’s office.
- B. Complete front & back of application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- C. Applicant’s signature must appear on the bottom right hand side of front (shown).
- D. Only ONE tag series (10 tags) will be issued per individual.

PHEASANT TAG HARVEST REPORT

The back of the application includes a survey with questions that have been developed in order to obtain information relative to pheasant hunting in Connecticut. Data from the survey will enable the State Department of Environmental Protection to better monitor pheasant stocking activities and hunter use patterns.

You will be asked to record all pheasant hunting activities in the State of Connecticut (only). NOT activities relating to private shooting preserves.

Survey Information:

1. Is this the first time you have purchased harvest tags in Connecticut?
2. Number of pheasants you harvested last season in state-owned, permit-required, state-leased or other areas.
3. Number of times you hunted in those areas.
4. Number of hours you spent hunting pheasant.
5. Did you hunt with a dog?
6. Number of times you hunted pheasant during October, November and December/January.
7. How much did you spend on pheasant hunting and related activities including license fees, equipment, ammo, meals, transportation, field trials, dogs, etc.
