## **Town Schedules Kickoff Meeting on Plan**

**GREENWICH**—The Planning and Zoning Commission has scheduled a kickoff meeting for Greenwich residents about preparation of the 2007 Plan of Conservation and Development. The meeting is intended to introduce the planning team to residents and provide an overview of the planning process.

Following this meeting, the overall planning process calls for a number of neighborhood meetings and topical meetings as part of the process of preparing the Plan. The overall goal is to give Greenwich residents ample opportunity to be involved in identifying issues and strategies for the Plan.

The current Plan of Conservation and Development for Greenwich was adopted in 1998. The current planning effort will evaluate that Plan and consider how it should be amended to reflect current issues and priorities.

Residents in Greenwich are encouraged to bring their views, concerns, and questions to this and subsequent workshops to ensure that the Plan of Conservation and Development accurately reflects the community's vision. "This Plan is an important document which will be used to guide future conservation and development activity over the next decade and beyond", said Donald Heller, Chairman of the Planning and Zoning Commission.

"It is important that a broad spectrum of Greenwich residents, business owners and local land use design professionals attend these workshops because the success of the Plan depends upon their input, interest, and involvement in its implementation," added Diane Fox, Greenwich's Planning and Zoning Director.

Preparation of the Plan will be coordinated by Planimetrics, an Avon-based consulting land use planning and consulting firm that specializes in helping Connecticut communities prepare Plans of Conservation and Development.
