REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING A FEDERAL TAX RETURN FOR 2005

Single	under 65	\$7,950
	65 or older	\$9,150
Married filing jointly***	under 65 (both spouses)	\$15,900
	65 or older (one spouse)	\$16,850
	65 or older (both spouses)	\$17,800
Married filing separately	any age	\$3,100
Head of Household	under 65	\$10,250
	65 or older	\$11,450
Qualifying widow (er) with Dependent child	under 65	\$12,800
	65 or older	\$13,750

*If you were born on January 1, 1941 you are considered to be age 65 at the end of 2005.

**Gross income means all income you received in the form of money, goods, property and services that is not exempt from tax, including any income from sources outside the United States (even if you may exclude part of all of it).

***If you did not live with your spouse at the end of 2005 (or on the date your spouse died) and your gross income was at least \$3,100 you must file a return regardless of age.
