The Town of Greenwich Department of Public Works was recently informed that the Cliffdale Road Bridge Reconstruction Project has been selected as one of the American Public Works Association's *Public Works Projects of the Year* for 2004. An award ceremony to recognize this achievement will be held at the 2004 International Public Works Congress and Exposition in Atlanta, Georgia, scheduled for September 13, 2004. This is the third award winning recognition that Public Works has received in the past year for projects it has managed.

Previously, the Connecticut Chapter of the Associated Building & Contractors, Inc. (ABC) recognized the historic restoration work on the Senior Center. This project was selected over nine competitors to receive ABC's Award of Excellence for 2003.

In addition, recently the Town of Greenwich Department of Public Works project upgrading the Grass Island Wastewater Treatment Plant received the American Council of Engineering Companies of New York Platinum Award in the 2004 Engineering Excellence Awards competition. The project entailed the planning, design, and construction for the Phase II biosolids handling upgrades to the Grass Island WWTP from 2001 to 2003.
