Oyster Harvesting Allowed

For a limited time from March 1, 2009 until the seasonal closing of the recreational Shellfish Beds at Greenwich Point, in early May 2009 (or as posted), the ban on taking oysters has been lifted and the taking of oysters is permitted.

A valid Shellfishing Permit is required at all times, as issued by the Town of Greenwich.

Only oysters of not less than three inches (3") in length may be taken and the number is limited to a maximum two gallons per person (permit holders only) per day in accordance with the Shellfish Regulations.

The total number of shellfish taken per person (permit holders only) per day, whether oysters, clams or a combination of each, shall not exceed this stated maximum of two gallons.
