Each citizen has the privilege of registering to vote on or before October 25, 2005 and may participate in the November 8, 2005, Municipal Election.

In the event of a municipal primary on September 13, 2005; the registration and enrollment cutoff date is Thursday, September 8, 2005, in person, September 12, 2005.

Any U.S. citizen 18 years old, or older, who is a bona fide resident of Greenwich, is eligible to register to vote. Qualified seventeen-year-old residents may "pre-register" to vote and will automatically become a voter on their 18th birthday. To register to vote, stop in at the Registrars of Voters or **telephone 622-7889 or 622-7890** and request a mail application form.

The Registrar's office is open Monday – Friday, 8:00AM-4:00PM. You may register to vote, change address, change name or join a political party. In order to accommodate those citizens unable to meet during regular work hours, the Registrars of Voters will hold "special voter registration sessions" on the following dates and times:
